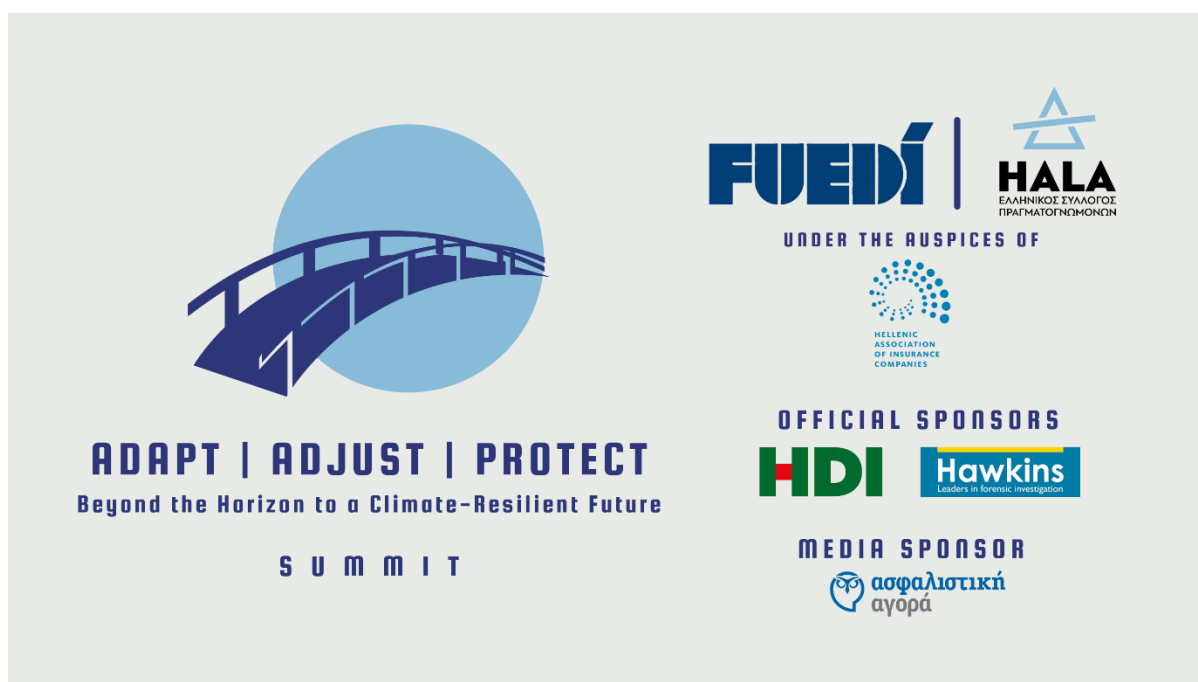


Terms and Conditions for Participation

1. **Introduction** Welcome to ADAPT | ADJUST | PROTECT event. By registering for and participating in this event, you confirm agreement to comply with the following terms and conditions.
2. **Event**

The event constitutes of two main sections that is:

 - i. The main section with with speeches and presentations. Maximum available capacity of venue 200 seats.
 - ii. The Cocktail at the Acropolis Museum Restaurant and the private guided tour at the museum. Maximum available capacity of venue 90 places.
3. **Registration**
 - All participants must complete the registration process.
 - Registration is complementary – free of charge but is non-transferable unless otherwise stated.
 - Registrations are made only through an online form. The registration link to access and fill in the form will be sent by e-mail and/or published to the event's page.
 - You will be asked to provide some information during registration that is necessary for the event's management. Indicatively you will need to provide your full name, contact details and job title. Doublecheck your e-mail for typos, otherwise your registration will fail. Further you will be asked to indicate any special requirements (e.g., dietary restrictions, accessibility needs). Moreover, you will be asked and must answer which section you are attending. You may choose to attend both subject to availability, but you may not choose to attend the cocktail at the Acropolis Museum Restaurant and the private guided tour at the museum, without attending the main section with with speeches and presentations.
 - As soon as you complete and submit the registration form you will see a confirmation message. In case you do see a confirmation message your registration is not valid / completed and you need to repeat the process.

- You can access the event only by showing your admission ticket, a QR code generated automatically. You will receive the QR code shortly before the event.

- Organizers retain the right to decide on the number of participants that will attend each section of the event. Acceptance of registration is on first to come first to be served basis.
- Organizers retain the right to refuse a registration.
- The deadline for registration is 30 April 2024, 17:00' EET, unless the maximum number of attendees is reached earlier.
- In case the event is cancelled for whatever reason organizers assume no liability. As the registration is complementary – free of charge no refund is ought.

4. Program
